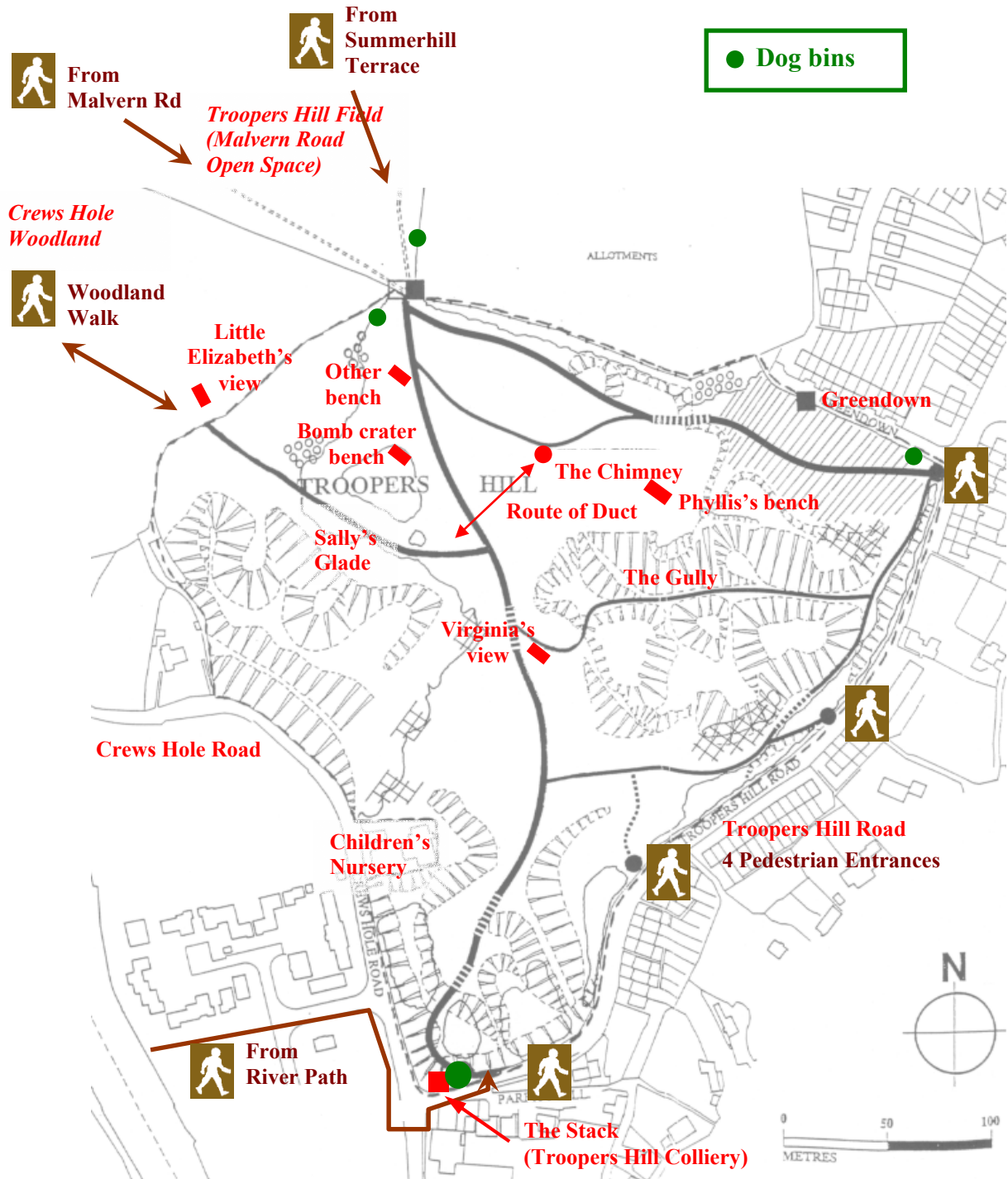


# Troopers Hill Local Nature Reserve
